Getting BYOD devices set up on the network

Students will use their personal devices to complete in-class activities, check grades, collaborate with other students and teachers, complete homework, conduct research, access websites with curriculumrelated content, keep track of classroom assignments, and record journal entries and other approved instructional activities. Students should only bring personal devices for a specific use in classes where the teacher/school has permitted them. Unless otherwise noted, devices are not to be used in open areas (hallways, cafeteria, locker rooms, bathrooms, stairwells, etc.)

Step 2: Configuring Network Settings

On your Mac, go into System Preferences
