Getting BYOD devices set up on the network

Students will use their personal devices to complete in-class activities, check grades, collaborate with other students and teachers, complete homework, conduct research, access websites with curriculum-related content, keep track of classroom assignments, and record journal entries and other approved instructional activities. Students should only bring personal devices for a specific use in classes where the teacher/school has permitted them. Unless otherwise noted, devices are not to be used in open areas (hallways, cafeteria, locker rooms, bathrooms, stairwells, etc.)

Step 1: Active Directory

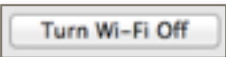
Please make sure your Active Directory Username and Password is up to date. You may go to: <https://secure.hcps.org/accounts/index.php> to reset your password or call the Help Desk at: x7004. You must reset your password using the temporary password on a networked (hardwired) computer.

Step 2: Configuring Network Settings

On your Mac, go into System Preferences

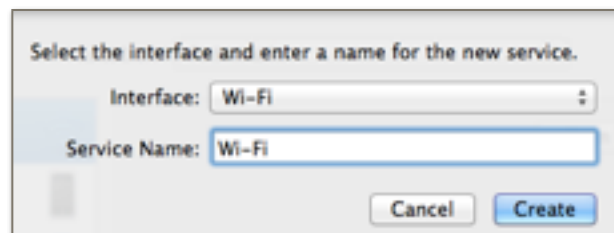
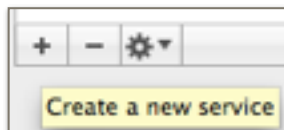


Select Network



Turn Wi-Fi Off

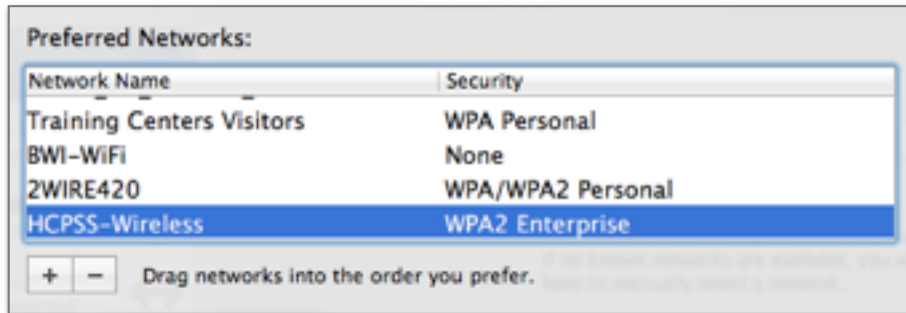
Add a new Wi-Fi network



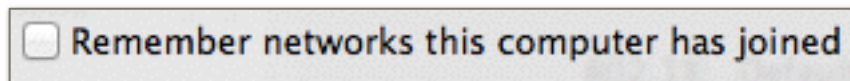
Select the Advanced option in the bottom right corner of the window.

Advanced...

Under the WiFi options, select the HCPSS-wireless network (if it appears) and delete it.



Make sure you have the “remember this network” box unchecked.

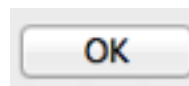


+ Add a new network

Type in HCPSS-Wireless, select the option of WPA2 Enterprise. Enter your Active Directory username and password. NOTE: If you are a student, you need to include the inst\ before your username.



Select the network you just added: HCPSS-Wireless and select



On the main screen, select the  button.

Turn on the Wi-Fi and select the network: HCPSS-Wireless
